I am a self-employed worker based abroad and I am coming to France to provide a service in the construction and public works sector : what formalities do I need to complete ?



If you are a self-employed worker posted to France to provide a service in the construction and public works sector, you must contact the social security authority to which you are affiliated before your departure in order to declare your service provision in France and request the A1 portable document which will certify that you are still covered by the social security scheme of your usual country of employment.

You must be able to present this document during your posting to France in the event of any checks carried out by the French authorities.
