I am a worker posted by my company to work on a construction or public works site in France : how can I access information about my rights ?



At construction and public works sites, information on the regulations applicable to posted workers must be displayed at the workplace in one of the official languages spoken in each of the countries to which the posted workers belong.

The poster presents information on the French labour law regulations applicable to posted workers in France with regard to working hours, minimum wages, accommodation, prevention of falls from a height, mandatory individual protective equipment and a right to withdraw in the event of any work situation posing a serious and imminent threat to the life or health of the posted worker.
